

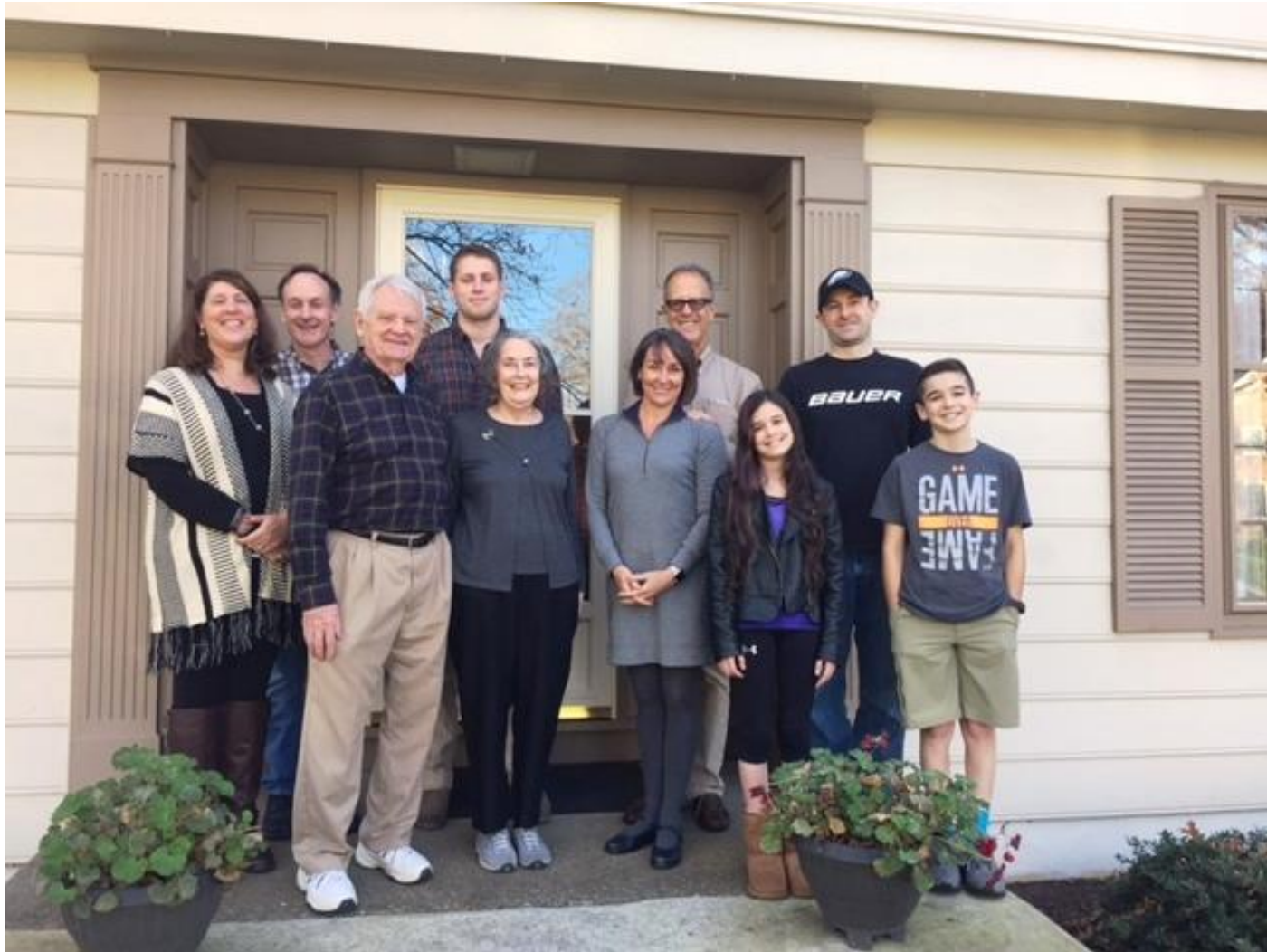
The Last Hurrah

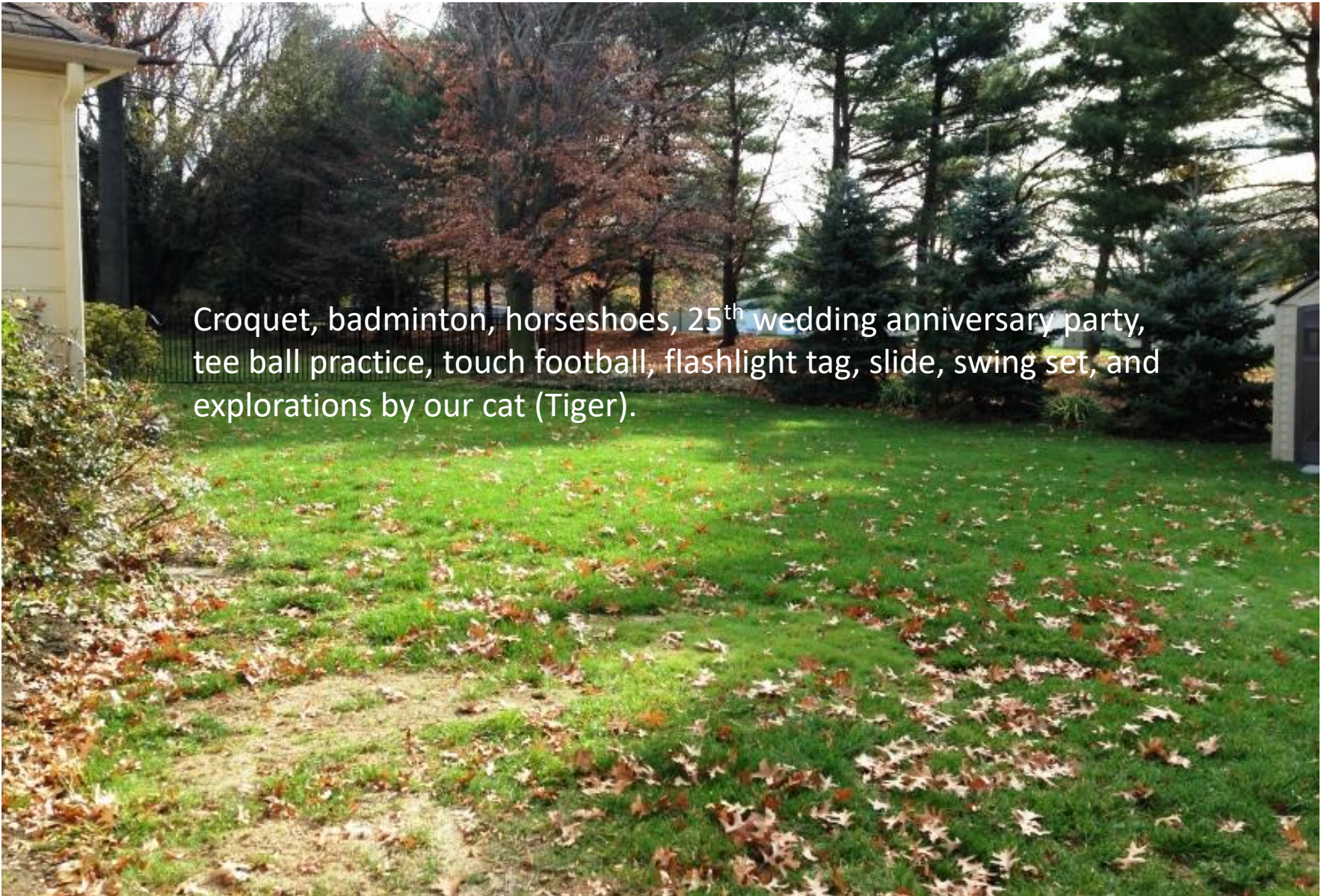


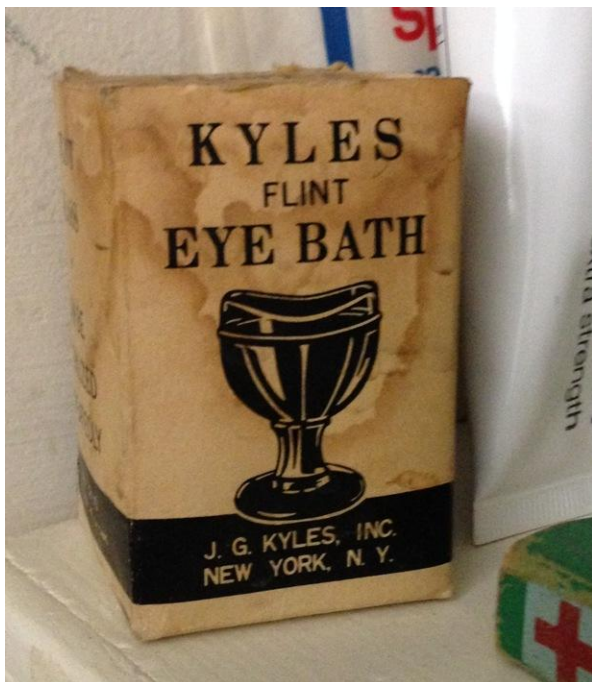
I expanded the powder room and built the laundry room.
