This spreadsheet shows the names of the males in a direct line from the earliest "found" Yarnall male (John Yearnold) to the latest Yarnall male in our branch of the family tree. **Generations are shown in the right column.** Red "gen" numbers indicate a split in our branch because unmarried distant cousins Eber and Eliza were the parents of William H. Yarnall. Caleb Sr (7) and John (8) are on the maternal side leading to Eliza (mother of William H). Job Sr (7) and Job Jr (8) are on the paternal side leading to Eber (father of William H).

The Yrs-Mos-Days column indicate length of life. The question marks appear because I was not able to find either the birth date or the death date.

My dad reached first place for longevity the hard way - 15 years infirmed by a stroke at age 66.
